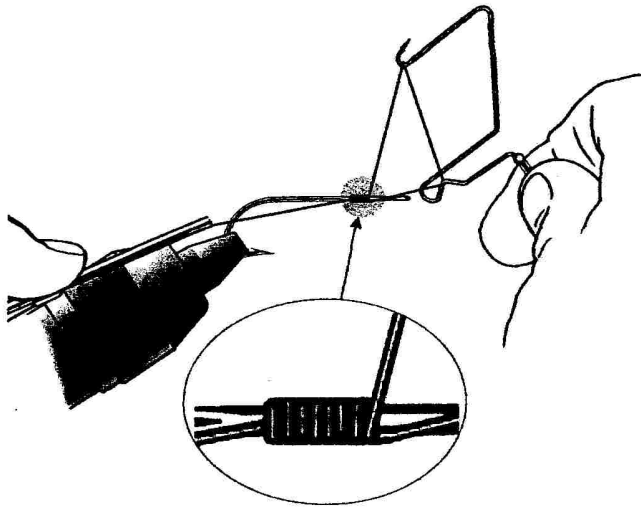
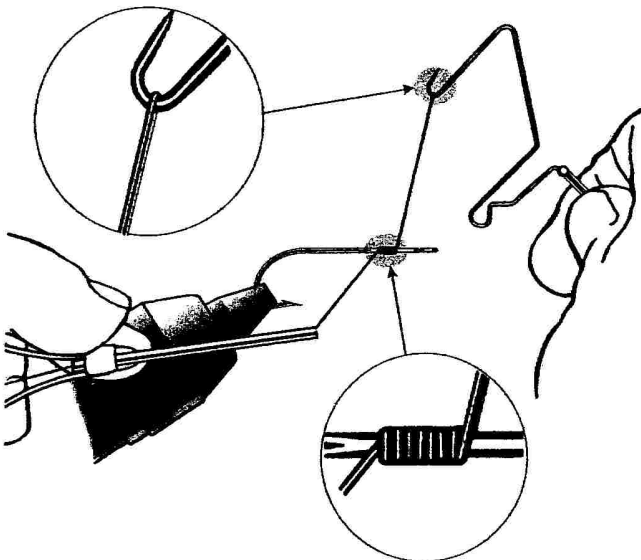


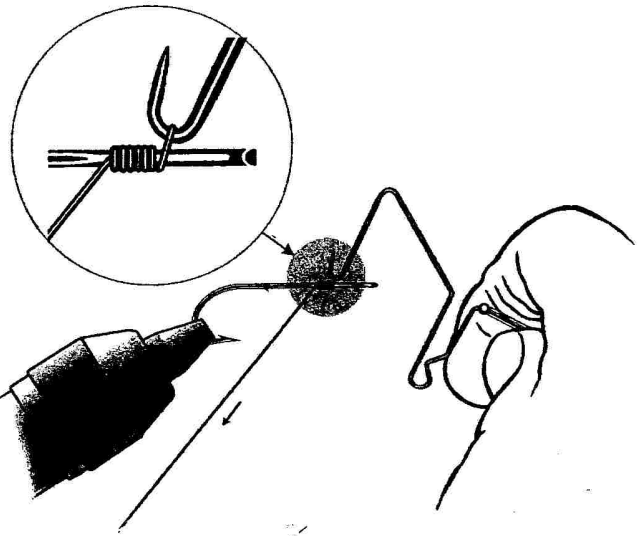
5. Wrap the thread 3 or 4 times around the hook.



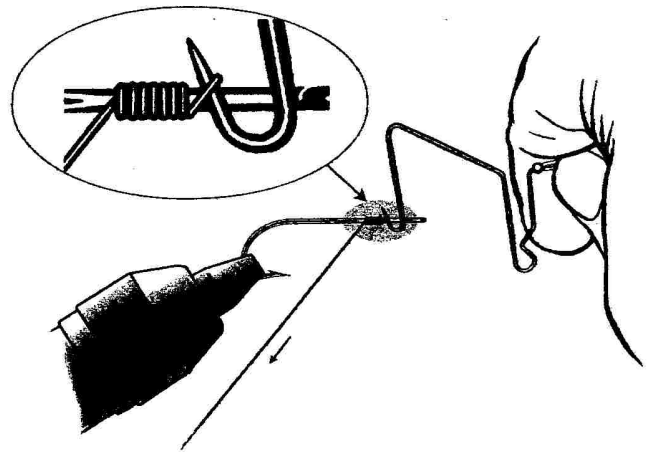
6. Disengage the thread from the notch by lifting the hook-end of the tool up . . .



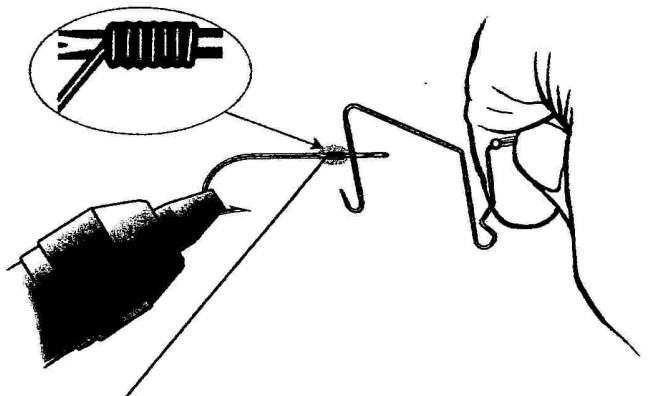
7. . . . and pulling back on the shaft to free the thread from the notch.



8. Pull the bobbin down to tighten the thread to the hook shank.



9. Maintaining downward tension on the bobbin, remove the tool and pull the thread tight.



10. The completed whip finish, ready for trimming.
