Total Results of Operations Total income of \$30,084 exceeds Budget by \$828. Expenses of \$26,685 are

less than Budget by \$2,665 resulting in a \$3,399 Surplus compared to a

budgeted Deficit of \$94.

Fundraising Unrestricted donations received totaled \$4,631. Donations for Vets on the

Fly and Fly Tying Classes totaled \$4,323. The IceBreaker raised \$5,013, the Meicher Auction raised \$2,204 and Chapter Meeting Bucket Raffles raised \$593. We also received a \$3,220 grant from Patagonia, a \$5,000 grant from

Cabela's and \$6,440 from the DNR River Protection Program.

Major Gifts and Donations Donations to other organizations totaled \$5,850 including \$4,000 to

Shabazz H.S. for Project Green Teen and \$1,000 to the Nohr Chapter of TU.

We also returned \$1,607 to Project Healing Waters.
