



Sawmill Creek Size Specific Catch Rates 2018




YOY (< 4.0") Brown Trout Catch Rates, Sawmill Creek 2018








Erickson Creek Size Specific Catch Rates 2018












Black Earth Creek Brown Trout Size Specific Catch Rates 2019




Young of Year (<4 in) Brown Trout Catch Rates, Black Earth Creek 2019















Brewery Creek Brown Trout Size Specific Catch Rates 2019




Garfoot Creek Brown Trout Size Specific Catch Rates 2019




Vermont Creek Brown Trout Size Specific Catch Rates 2019








Elvers Creek and Moen Creek Brown Trout Size Specific Catch Rates 2019







- Dane County- Kittleson Valley Creek @ Drammen Valley Road
 - 3,000 ft Bank sloping, overhead woody cover, replant trees 2021
- Black Earth Creek tree planting: Fishery Area @ HWY KP entrance
 - April 8-10th-ish.
 - ~ 200 trees to be planted
- Richland County:
 - 2020-Willow Creek along Smythe Hollow Road:3,000 ft bank sloping & habitat
 - 2021-Mill Creek along CTH E, north of Boaz-bank sloping & habitat
- Grant County 2019-2020:
 - Grant River north of Lancaster, HWY K
- \$\$ Temperature loggers is a need and worth TU consideration, each logger is ~ \$35-40, would need 30-50 to canvas a watershed.
